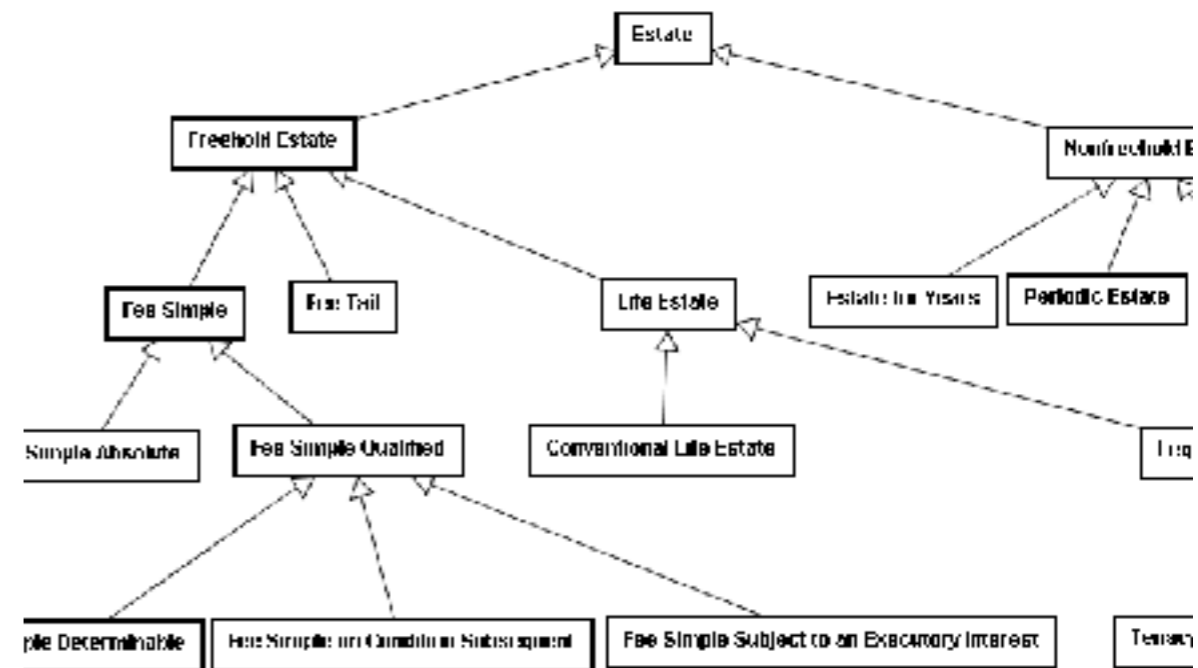

bu-reauc-ra-cy (noun)

- a highly organized body of workers with many levels of authority.
- Like many emperors before, China was run with the help of a large bureaucracy.



war-lord (noun)

- a military leader operating outside the control of the government
- This led warlords to oppose the emperor and fight with one another.



civil service examination (noun)

- a test given to qualify candidate for positions in the government
- Civil Service Examinations were created to improve the bureaucracy.



mer-i-toc-ra-cy (noun)

- rule by officials of proven merit.
- They created a meritocracy by giving civil service examinations.



ar-is-toc-ra-cy (noun)

- government by wealthy land owners.
- Many emperors relied on the aristocracy of wealthy landowners.



im-per-i-al (adj)

- of or relating to an empire.
- Imperial China was ruled by many dynasties.



for-eign-er (noun)

- a person born or coming from a country other than one's own.
- Under Mongol emperors, government officials were foreigners.
